This expedition promises thrilling off-road adventures in a 4x4, showcasing the majestic mountains, mesmerizing valleys, and snow-covered trails of Spiti.

Day 1 Delhi to Shimla

Board your overnight AC Volvo from Kashmiri Gate or RK Ashram, Delhi. A comfortable 8–9 hour journey through the night brings you to the gateway of the Himalayas.

Day 2 Shimla to Narkanda

A scenic 65 km drive ascending to ~2,700 m through Kufri and Theog — apple orchards, towering pine forests, and sweeping Himalayan vistas await on this beautiful mountain leg.



Route & Distance

65 km via Kufri & Theog — approx. 2–3 hours



Highlights

Beautiful apple orchards, pine forests, mountain landscapes, and peaceful surroundings of Narkanda.

Day 3

Narkanda to Kalpa

A breathtaking 165 km drive through Kinnaur Valley via Rampur, Jeori, and Wangtu — 6–7 hours of stunning views along the Sutlej River with the mighty Kinner Kailash peak watching over you.



Route & Distance

Via Sangla Valley · ~165 km · Winding mountain roads

Altitude & Duration

Approx. 2,296 m · 6–7 hours · Multiple scenic photo stops. The route has winding mountain roads. Keep medicines and essentials handy.

Day 4 Kalpa to Tabo

Via Khab Sangam & Nako — ~150 km | Altitude: 3,280 m | 5–6 hours through the ancient Spiti valley

Day 5 Tabo to Kaza

Via Pin Valley* · Dhankar Monastery · Kaza
~110 km · Altitude: 3,650 m · 5–6 hrs drive
*Pin Valley access subject to road & snow conditions

Kaza Base Camp

Overnight at Kaza — carry warm layers & UV sunglasses. Stay hydrated due to high altitude. Keep warm layers and sunglasses handy.

Day 6 - Kaza Local Sightseeing

Approx. 60–80 km around Kaza | Altitude ~3,650 m
Local sightseeing covering Key Monastery, Chicham Bridge,
Kibber, Langza, Hikkim, and Komic.

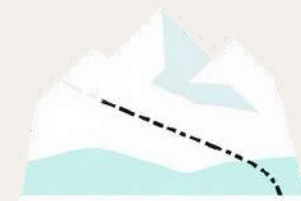

Day 7 Kaza to Kalpa

A long and breathtaking return drive through the Kinnaur Valley — 210 km of winding mountain roads via Tabo and Nako, descending from the Spiti plateau back toward the green valleys of Kinnaur.



Route & Distance

210 km | Via Tabo, Nako & Kinnaur Valley | 7–8 hrs | Alt. ~2,296 m



Drive Highlights

Enjoy the changing landscapes from cold desert mountains to green Kinnaur valleys. Start early for a comfortable journey. Road conditions may vary.

Day 8

Kalpa to Shimla & Delhi

Drive ~220 km through the Kinnaur Valley alongside the Sutlej River. Savour your last Himalayan vistas before the overnight Volvo journey back to Delhi.

7-8 hrs via Kinnaur Valley & Sutlej River viewpoints. Keep cameras ready for beautiful viewpoints along the route.

- Snow-chain support (if required due to heavy snowfall)

Terms & Conditions

- **Jurisdiction:** All disputes arising out of or in connection with tour packages booked with Unexplored Himachal shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts and tribunals located in Kullu District, Himachal Pradesh, India.
- **Booking Policy:** All bookings are accepted strictly on a first-come, first-served basis. Bookings are non-transferable, non-adjustable, and cannot be rescheduled, except where explicitly allowed. Trips may be rescheduled only if requested at least 45 days prior to the trip start date, subject to availability. In case of cancellation from the traveler's end, no booking amount shall be refunded or adjusted under any circumstances. The transfer of bookings is strictly prohibited — only individuals named on the confirmation invoice may travel.
- **Identification & Boarding:** Travelers must carry a valid Government-issued Photo ID (Aadhar Card, Driving License, Voter ID, or Passport) during the journey. ID verification is mandatory prior to boarding; boarding will not be permitted without valid identification.
- **Content Rights:** All photo and video content created during Unexplored Himachal trips (by either our content creators or participants) is the sole property of Unexplored Himachal. The company reserves the right to use such content for promotional and advertising purposes across any media platforms.
- **Itinerary & Transportation:** Unexplored Himachal reserves the right to modify, rearrange, or cancel any part of the itinerary or transportation arrangements due to unforeseen or unavoidable circumstances such as adverse weather, political unrest, local union issues, or other similar events.
- **Liability & Responsibility:** Travelers must follow all safety instructions provided by trip leaders and professionals during activities. All adventure activities offered are government-approved and conducted under expert supervision. However, Unexplored Himachal shall not be held liable for any injury, accident, loss, or damage occurring due to participation in any adventure sport or travel-related incident, nor for natural or man-made calamities impacting the trip.
- **Cancellations & Misconduct:** In case of adverse weather, government restrictions, or operational constraints, activities may be rescheduled or canceled without prior notice. Any misconduct, misbehavior, or inappropriate behavior during the trip will not be tolerated, and Unexplored Himachal reserves the right to cancel such bookings immediately without refund. Unexplored Himachal also reserves the right to cancel any trip or individual booking at its discretion without prior notice.

Amendment Policy(Propone & Postpone)

- In case client wishes to prepone /postpone his or her travel dates, we request you to kindly reach us 15 days prior to journey date via e-mail.
- The customers can prepone /postpone their tour once without any additional charges (if intimated before 15 days of travel date in written). However postponing & preponing second time will attract additional charges. Also note that few service providers (Hoteliers, Transporter etc.) may apply postpone/prepone charges even after meeting above requirement. In such cases postpone/prepone charges will be deducted from the advance amount deposited.
- In all prepone or postpone scenarios, the services and the costing will be subject to availability of Hotel/Volvo and season/off season time. We do not accept any changes in plan within 15 days of travel date. However in rare cases like adverse climatic conditions or strikes, package can be postponed which will be intimated to you beforehand.
- The validity to utilize your Advance payment in prepone/postpone scenarios is 1 Year from the date of advance payment.
- The advance payment and the invoice Number allotted to you, are transferable i.e. you can pass on your booking to any of your friends/ relatives. (Please Note: In order to transfer your booking you must meet the above terms and conditions first).

Cancellation of Booking by participant:

- Booking amount is non refundable.
- Cancellations up to 50 days prior to departure date – 10% deduction
- Cancellations up to 30 days prior to departure date - 30% deduction
- Between 30 days to 15 days prior to departure - 50% deduction
- Less than 15 days of departure - No Cash Refund
- Please note that in case of booking with a partial amount, the deduction amount would be calculated with respect to the overall event fees only.
- The amount would be adjusted from the partial amount deposited to calculate the final refund amount.
- The amount for refund processing would always be calculated on the basis of the net amount paid* for booking the event w.r.t the Base Price of the event (excluding additional components like transport, rent, portage, etc.).
- In case, clients are suspected to indulge in any kind of illegal activity or violent behavior, we will immediately stop the services while holding all the refunds.
